Executive Committee Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM by President Tony Gallo.

Purpose of meeting:

Review various options for possibly accommodating close-in 3D aerobatics at the EFR, as proposed by club member Tom Aldrich. Close-in aerobatics is in conflict with rule #8 in the published SLO Flyers, Inc. Flight Operations Regulations. Rule #8 states, "Any aerobatics or high speed passes by any type of aircraft will be beyond the west edge of the runway."

Discussion:

Various locations within the EFR perimeter were considered, including the area north of the Helicopter pad and on the east edge of the runway. Also considered was allowing 3D aerobatics over the runway, limited to designated time slots on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month.

Tony Gallo motioned that we adopt a 90-day trial plan that allows close-in 3D aerobatics over the runway on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday mornings of each month (hours TBD). All other Safety rules and Flight Operations regulations shall remain in effect at all times. The motion was unanimously passed.

Additional discussion:

Morgan Wilson motioned that language be added to the membership application form that clarifies the authority of the Executive Committee. Motion unanimously passed.

Steve Willison noted occasional congestion at the EFR, so suggested the Executive Committee consider capping SLO Flyers, Inc. membership. Current membership stands at 54. A reasonable cap might be 65 members. Discussion to be continued at a future Executive Committee meeting.

President Tony Gallo adjourned the meeting at 10:00 AM.
